

**2017 Midwest Regional Jr. Suffolk Show**  
**Ohio State Fair**  
**August 3, 2017**

**\* General Rules:**

- \* The Mid West Regional Jr. Suffolk Show is open to exhibitors who are 21 years of age or less as of August 3, 2017.
- \* Ownership must be recorded in the junior's name, or immediate family or farm name.
- \* Deadline for ownership is July 2, 2017. All registration certificates are required and must be duly processed by the United Suffolk Sheep Association.
- \* Juniors must be present to show their own entries unless physically impaired. If two animals are entered in the same class, another junior must show the other entry. With no lower limit, the junior exhibitor must still be physically capable of showing (setting legs or holding head) his or her own sheep
- \* Entry dead line will be July 8<sup>th</sup>. All entries must be postmarked by July 8<sup>th</sup>. Appropriate entry fees must be enclosed.

- Checks for entry fees should be made out to Midwest Regional Suffolk Show c/o Pat Wiford
- \* All Sheep must be in place by 10:00pm Wednesday, August 2nd. If a late arrival or early release is needed, please contact either Pat or Sam Wiford ([sampat@watchtv.net](mailto:sampat@watchtv.net))
- Registration Papers must be checked in by 11:00am Thursday August 3rd, 2017. See Pat Wiford for registration paper check-in.
- \* Exhibitors will be restricted to two entries per class. Class splits will be posted day of show.
  - \* All sheep entered must bear the registration number of the United Suffolk Sheep Association.
  - \* No inhumane treatment of animals will be allowed. No muzzles allowed.
  - \* Neither the Midwest Regional Jr. Suffolk Show management nor the Ohio State Fair Will be held responsible in case of any accidents.
  - \* There will be Senior and Junior Champions in the Ewe Division.
  - \* Pay-out will be determined by using sliding scale.

**Health Requirements:**

- \* **Sheep moved within Ohio for Exhibition:**
  - \* The animal presented for exhibition must show no symptoms or evidence of an infectious or contagious disease.
- \* **Sheep imported into Ohio for Exhibition:**
  - \* Must have a certificate of veterinary inspection issued within thirty days preceding the exhibition opening date; and
  - \* The animal presented for exhibition must show no symptoms or evidence of an

infectious or contagious disease; and

- \* The owner and the veterinarian must attest to the following statement written on the certificate of veterinary inspection **“the sheep in this shipment are not known to be under any movement restriction because of scrapie.”**

- \* **All Sheep must carry a USDA S scrapie tag.**

- \*
