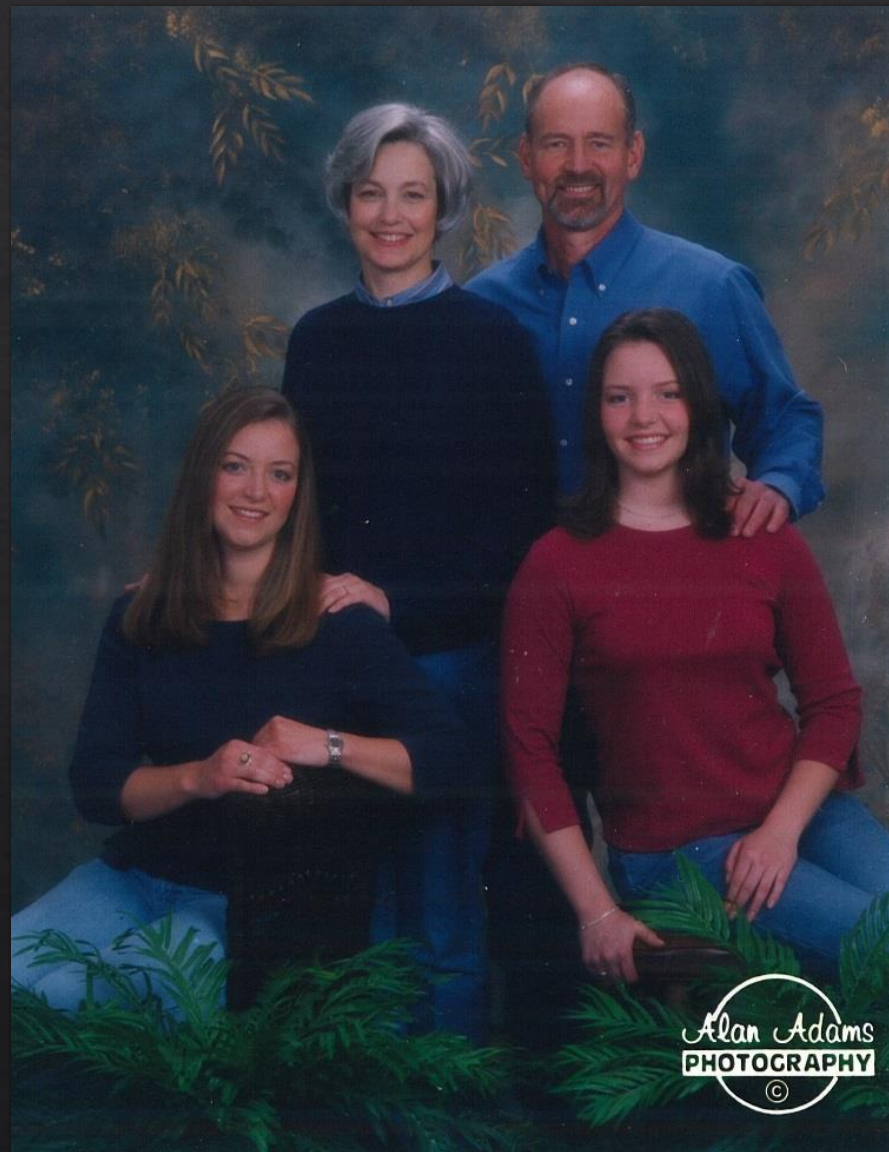

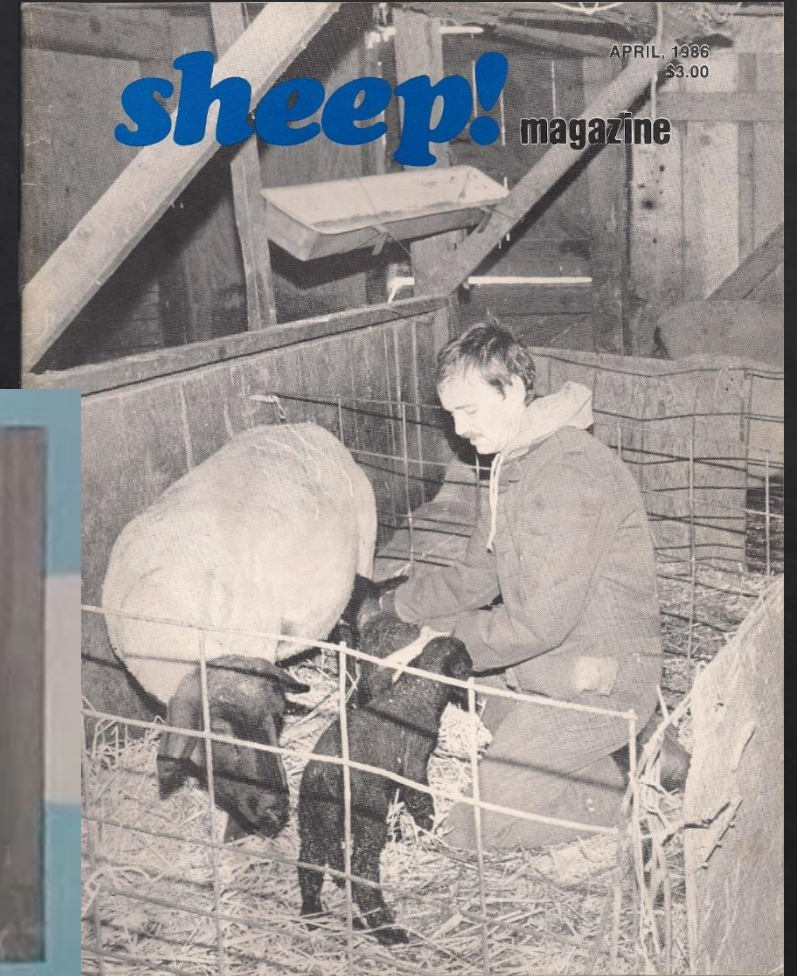
"Meteorologist"

Officially 35" tall and apparently the boniest-boned lamb in Louisville. "Meteorologist" weighed 252 pounds at 278 days after weaning over 90 ewes. One of the three highest weight-for-ages at the National Show and we know his February 10th birth date is right. He weighed 108 pounds at 71 days and 182 pounds at 148 days.
